



Elementary Student Expectations During eLearning

As we transition to eLearning, students will follow the expectations/guidelines that have been designed to support the JCSC eLearning platform:

- Students will be expected to participate in learning and complete all assignments from home during this time.
- It is critical that you stay caught up on your schoolwork. Please reach out to your teachers if you have any questions or need assistance with lessons/assignments.
- Please continually check your school email and Google and/or SeeSaw Classroom. These are the main ways your teachers will be communicating with you. Attendance for eLearning is determined by student engagement. Ways to show engagement are through communication with the teacher, assignment completion, and/or attending daily meets. Students without internet access will show engagement through paper packet assignment completion.
- Students will be completing classroom work online or paper packets if needed. Teachers will be planning optional Google Meets for your classes. Please pay close attention to your email and Google Classroom for these types of announcements. Elementary students will have live Google Meets for instruction available, but they are NOT required. Teachers will be using the Google Meet to review high-priority grade level standards lessons. The optional Google Meets will be scheduled between the hours of 9:00am to 2:00pm and will be 30-45 min. in length twice daily.
- All students are expected to complete their assignments fully in a timely manner in order to receive credit for their work. Grades for virtual learning will be recorded based upon the work quality and mastery of standards. If a student is not completing work that shows mastery of the grade-level standards, failing grades would be considered appropriate in the same manner as the in-person traditional setting.
- If necessary, school Wi-Fi can be accessed from any JCSC school's parking lot. If this is an option you choose to take advantage of, please remain in your vehicle.
